



Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of the plans for the Year 6 leavers' activities, we are proposing an Enterprise Day in order to raise money. The day will be run by Year 6 children allowing them to develop their leadership skills and wider responsibilities. As part of the day, children from the other years will be given the opportunity to take part in games or events with the chance of winning small prizes.

Children will pay **£3 via ParentPay** to take part in the games which will then go towards the cost of some of the Year 6 leavers' events. This Enterprise Day will take place on **Thursday, 24<sup>th</sup> June**.

In order to minimise any COVID risks, children will take part in the events on the school field and shall remain in small groups within their class bubbles. Each game will be set up to adhere to social distancing rules. This is to avoid any children crossing the class bubbles, which we have done our best to keep separate, since coming back to school following the National Lockdown. Activities have been chosen to eliminate any need for the mixing of class bubbles. After each year group has completed an activity, any equipment, e.g. hoops or balls will be disinfected and hand sanitiser provided for the children.

The games and activities will include:

- Beat the goalie
- Wet the teacher
- Hoopla
- Guess the name of the teddy
- Play your cards right
- Wet run & slip'n'slide

There will also be an ice pop for each child that would like one. **Children are also allowed to attend school in non-uniform**. All activities are subject to change depending on the weather. Any activities that are included will again adhere to Covid guidelines.

Children may wish to bring a **change of clothes** as they may get wet on some of the activities.

In addition, Year 6 will be running a colouring competition and raffle with prizes donated by local businesses and Year 6 parents/carers. There will be an **extra cost of £1** if you would like to enter the raffle and competition.
